



COVID-19 response as of 19th March 2020

We have paused our regular community projects timetable to help to slow down the spread and reduce the burden on the NHS.

We are committed to our neighbourhood and ensuring that our community comes together at a time of social isolation for so many over the coming month.

While we are taking all responsible measures to ensure that we minimise the spread of infection, we are not completely closing our doors by coordinating creative action at a community level to provide ongoing support to those in need.

Families Programme

Most of our families programme (Wednesday Playgroup and Lunch, Dance & Movement for Mums, Thursday Messy Play, over 50s dance and the Intergenerational Café) will not be taking place until further notice.

Our Monday and Friday Kitchen Club will have a different format offering a take-away and foodbank vouchers to anyone who needs them, sharing Public Health England guidance and signposting as required.

Adult Provision

Our Wednesday Clapton Community Drop In session will also take a different format for now; we will be offering take-away food, advice about best hygiene practice, food bank vouchers and only meeting with people if they are facing an emergency situation.

Our Sunday Urban Table will offer take-away food and food bank vouchers and Drop In Volunteer available only for emergency situations.

We are closed from **Friday 20th March** until further notice following the decision by the government.
