



## **Food Delivery Volunteers**

### **Volunteer Job Description**

We currently deliver meals on Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays.

This role involves delivering meals to residents in the most vulnerable circumstances. Food deliveries will require some contact with residents, some of whom are the most oppressed and forgotten in society.

You have the support of the drop in coordinator if there are any issues that arise in the course of your deliveries, such as concerns you may have for a resident's wellbeing or safety.

### Role Requirements

- Volunteers must be over 18 years old.
- Ability to carry a couple of bags of food, on foot or by vehicle.
- Face masks and hand sanitiser to be worn and used while picking up and delivering food, unless you are exempt. These can be provided at the Round Chapel if required but we have limited stock.
- Your own vehicle, should you require or wish to use one.
- If using a vehicle, the appropriate license and insurance to operate that vehicle (where applicable).
- We will make sure that we keep the people we are in contact with safe and all volunteers will need a DBS check, which we will be able to help you with.

- Supporting the people in your local community.
- Exercise and travel around the local neighbourhood.
